The integumentary system refers to the skin and its accessory structures. In the adult human body, the skin makes up about 16 percent of body weight and covers an area of 1.5 to 2 m<sup>2</sup>. In fact, the skin and accessory structures are the largest organ system in the human body.

A recent evidence-based review concluded that there is no one test that is the gold standard for diagnosis. Tests are divided into two categories: Tests that confirm the presence of an active infection in order to make an informed decision (eg, treat or not, euthanize, quarantine)

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Other commonly used treatments include cryotherapy, surgical or laser excision, and local immune modulation (Bacillus Calmette-Guérin [BCG] therapy). Surgical excision with margins of at least 0.5-1 cm is recommended. Preplaced sutures or releasing incisions are often needed for primary closure.
