A trauma assessment can determine strengths as well as clinical symptoms of traumatic stress. It assesses the severity of symptoms, and can determine the impact of trauma (how thoughts, emotions, and behaviors have been changed by trauma) on the child's functioning in the various well-being domains .

Trauma-Based Screenings and Assessments Screening and assessing for trauma symptoms, especially in regard to determining how trauma affects healthy functioning, are essential in determining a child's overall social and emotional well-being. Children usually present to a child welfare agency as a result of a specific incident of maltreatment.

Trauma-Informed Mental Health Assessment refers to a process that includes a clinical interview, standardized measures, and/or behavioral observations designed to gather an in-depth understanding of the nature, timing, and severity of the traumatic events, the effects of those events, current trauma-related symptoms, and functional impairment.
